

Unlock the packaging locks:



- 1 Turn the packaging locks 90 degrees anticlockwise several times.
- 2 Pull out and discard the packaging locks.


GETTING STARTED

WARNING:

Adult assembly required for battery installation. Keep batteries out of reach of children.

Battery Removal and Installation

- 1. Make sure the unit is turned Off.
- Find the battery cover located on the back of Whale Piano, use a screwdriver to loosen the screw, and then open the battery cover.
- 3. Remove old batteries by pulling up on one end of each battery.
- Install 2 new AAA (AM-4/LR03)
 batteries following the diagram inside the battery box. (For best performance, alkaline batteries or fully charged Ni-MH rechargeable batteries are recommended).
- 5. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.



IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION

- Insert batteries with the correct polarity (+ and -).
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable batteries.
- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.
- Do not short-circuit the supply terminals.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of batteries in fire.

RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES

- Remove rechargeable batteries (if removable) from toy before charging.
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- · Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.

Disposal of batteries and product



The crossed-out wheelie bin symbols on products and batteries, or on their respective packaging, indicates they must not be disposed of in domestic waste as they contain substances that can be damaging to the environment and human health.

The chemical symbols Hg, Cd or Pb, where marked, indicate that the battery contains more than the specified value of mercury (Hg), cadmium (Cd) or lead (Pb) set out in the Batteries and Accumulators Regulation.

PRODUCT FEATURES

1. On/Off/Volume Switch

To turn the unit On, slide the On/Off/
Volume Switch to the Low volume

or High volume



2. Mode Switch

To choose a mode of play, slide the **Mode Switch** to the Music mode $\binom{i,j}{3}$, Piano mode $(\frac{i,j}{3})$, or Explore mode $(\frac{2}{3})$ position.



To preserve battery life, the Ocean Buddies Animal Band will automatically power down after approximately 30 seconds without input. The unit can be turned On again by pressing any button.

NOTE

If the unit powers down or if the light fades out during play, please install a new set of batteries.

ACTIVITIES

1. Light Up Piano Keys

Press the **Light Up Piano Keys** to hear songs and melodies in Music mode, hear piano notes and music in the Piano mode, and learn about ocean animals, colours and numbers in Explore mode. The lights will flash with the sound.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

- 1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
- Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat sources.
- Remove the batteries if the unit will not be in use for an extended period of time.
- Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces and do not expose the unit to moisture or water.
- 5. If the unit stops working or malfunctions, install a new set of batteries.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the program/activity stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

- Please turn the unit Off.
- 2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
- 3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
- 4. Turn the unit **On**. The unit should now be ready to play with again.
- If the product still does not work, install a brand new set of batteries.
