



### **GETTING STARTED**

### **Battery Removal and Installation**

- 1. Make sure the unit is turned Off.
- Find the battery cover located on the back of the unit, use a screwdriver to loosen the screw, and then open the battery cover.
- 3. Remove the old battery by pulling up on one end of the battery.



- Install 2 new AA (AM-3/LR6) battery following the diagram inside the battery box. (For best performance, alkaline batteries or fully charged Ni-MH rechargeable batteries are recommended).
- 5. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.

### WARNING:

Adult assembly required for battery installation. Keep batteries out of reach of children.

### **IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION**

- Insert batteries with the correct polarity (+ and -).
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable batteries.
- Only batteries of the same or equivalent typeas recommended are to be used.
- Do not short-circuit the supply terminals.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of batteries in fire.

### **RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES:**

- Remove rechargeable batteries (if removable) from toy before charging.
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.

### **ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS**

1. Attach the C-ring's to the fabric loops on both sides of the cow.





2. Insert the fabric loops into the holes on the back of the piano then secure using the velcro.



3. Put the balls into the ball pit.





# **PRODUCT FEATURES**

#### 1. Off/Low/High Volume Control Switch

To turn the unit **On**, slide the **Off/ Low/Volume Switch** to the Low volume  $\P$ ? or the High Volume  $\P$ ? position. You will hear a sound, a phrases and a song. To turn the unit **Off**  $\P$ , slide the **Off/Low/Volume Switch** to the **Off**  $\P$  position.

#### 2. Mode Switch

Slide the Mode Switch to Music Mode, Animal Mode or Learning Mode position.

#### 3. Automatic Shut Off

To preserve battery life, the **Electronic Moosical Piano** will automatically shut off after approximately 30 seconds without input. The unit can be turned on again by pressing any button.

#### NOTE

If the piano powers down or if the light fades out during play, please install a new set of batteries.

#### IMPORTANT NOTE

Please remove the plastic film from the mirror and discard before use.

# ACTIVITIES

 Light Up Piano Buttons
 Music Mode - Press the Piano Buttons to hear fun sounds, sing-along songs and melodies.

 Animal Mode - learn about animals and their sounds.
 Learning Mode - learn numbers, counting, colours and play question and answer games. The lights will flash with the sounds.

#### 2. Ball pit play

Have a blast with the 30 included multicoloured balls. Grab, squeeze and throw them around to support motor skills, then tidy up and store the balls inside the Cow's head.

### 3. Exploring Play

Playing with the apple mirror, textured carrot and electronic piano support important developmental milestones. Explore textures by playing with the squeaky horns, crinkly ears and soft body.

### **CARE & MAINTENANCE**

- 1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
- 2. Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat sources.
- 3. Remove the batteries if the unit will not be in use for an extended period of time.
- 4. Do not drop the unit on a hard surface and do not expose the unit to moisture or water.

# TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the unit stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

- 1. Please turn the unit Off.
- 2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
- 3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
- 4. Turn the unit **On**. The unit should now be ready to play again.
- 5. If the unit still does not work, install a new set of batteries.
