

PRODUCT FEATURES



Mode Switch (Lights Mode – Music Mode – Motion Mode)

Slide to Lights Mode to enjoy magical light patterns.

Slide to Music Mode to listen to fun songs.

Slide to Motion Mode to jam with the sound effects.

2. Motion Sensor

Shake the bag to jam with the sound effects. No response in Lights Mode and Music Mode.

- Touch Sensor Touch to change the Light/Song.
- On-Off Switch Slide to switch the power on or off.

GETTING STARTED

Battery Removal and Installation

- 1. Make sure the unit is turned Off. □ □ □ □
- Open the bag and locate the battery box at the bottom. Use a screwdriver to loosen the screw and then open the battery cover.
- If used batteries are present, remove these batteries from the unit by pulling up on one end of each battery.
- 4. Install 2 new AA (AM-3/LR6) batteries following the diagram inside the battery box. (For best performance, alkaline batteries or fully charged Ni-MH rechargeable batteries are recommended.)
- 5. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.

WARNING:

Adult assembly required for battery installation. Keep batteries out of reach of children.

IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION

- Insert batteries with the correct polarity (+ and -).
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable batteries.
- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.

- · Do not short-circuit the supply terminals.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- · Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of batteries in fire.

RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES:

- Remove rechargeable batteries (if removable) from toy before charging.
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- · Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.

Disposal of batteries and product



The crossed-out wheelie bin symbols on products and batteries, or on their respective packaging, indicates they must not be disposed of in domestic waste as they contain substances that can be damaging to the environment and human health.

The chemical symbols Hg, Cd or Pb, where marked, indicate that the battery contains more than the specified value of mercury (Hg), cadmium (Cd) or lead (Pb) set out in the Batteries and Accumulators Regulation.

The solid bar indicates that the product was placed on the market after 13th August, 2005.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

- 1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
- Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat sources.
- 3. Remove the batteries if the unit will not be in use for an extended period of time.
- Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces and do not expose the unit to moisture or water.
- If the unit stops working or malfunctions, install a new set of batteries.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the unit stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

- 1. Turn the unit Off.
- 2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
- 3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
- 4. Turn the unit On. The unit should now be ready to use again.
- 5. If the unit still does not work, install a new set of batteries.
