INTRODUCTION

The **Counting Hoops Basketball Stand** can be adjusted from heights between 1075mm/3'6" and 1400mm/4'7", and offers 3 different activities to grow with your child. Go solo or gather some friends to practise your skills! It's a slam dunk!


Adult assembly required for battery installation. Keep batteries out of reach of children.

Battery Removal and Installation

- 1. Make sure the unit is turned OFF.
- 2. Locate the battery cover on the back of the unit. Use a screwdriver to loosen the screw and then open the battery cover.
- 3. If used batteries are present, remove these batteries from the unit by pulling up on one end of each battery.
- 4. Install 3 new AA (AM-3/LR6) batteries following the diagram inside the battery box. (For best performance, alkaline batteries or fully charged Ni-MH rechargeable batteries are recommended).
- 5. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.

IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION

- Insert batteries with the correct polarity (+ and -).
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable batteries.
- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.



- Do not short-circuit the supply terminals.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of batteries in fire.

RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES:

- Remove rechargeable batteries (if removable) from toy before charging.
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.

Disposal of batteries and product



The crossed-out wheelie bin symbols on products and batteries, or on their respective packaging, indicates they must not be disposed of in domestic waste as they contain substances that can be damaging to the environment and human health.

The chemical symbols Hg, Cd or Pb, where marked, indicate that the battery contains more than the specified value of mercury (Hg), cadmium (Cd) or lead (Pb) set out in the Batteries and Accumulators Regulation.



The solid bar indicates that the product was placed on the market after 13th August, 2005.



ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

With the **Counting Hoops Basketball Stand**, safety comes first. Adult assembly required. For your child's safety, do not let them play with this toy until it is fully assembled.

NOTE: To prevent the **Counting Hoops Basketball Stand** from falling over and causing injury, the base must be filled fully with sand or water. **DO NOT** let your child play with this toy until the base has been fully filled.








PRODUCT FEATURES


1. On/Off/Mode Switch

Slide the **On/Off/Mode Switch** to choose an activity or turn the unit off. Choose from three activities.



2. Mute/Volume Switch

To adjust the volume, slide the **Mute/Volume Switch** right to Low or High, or slide the switch left to turn off the sound.



3. Select Button

Use the **Select Button** to choose a theme for **Copy Cat**, a level for **Aim For The Shape**, or choose between 1 or 2 player mode for **Buzzer Beater Challenge**.



4. Automatic Shut-Off

To preserve battery life, the **Counting Hoops Basketball Stand** will automatically shut off after several minutes without input. The unit can be turned on again by sliding the **On/Off/Mode Switch**.

TO BEGIN PLAY

Slide the On/Off/Mode Switch to the right and select a game to play.

ACTIVITIES

1. Copy Cat

Slide the **On/Off/Mode Switch** to to enter this activity.

Press the **Select Button** to choose a theme: Busy Bugs, Monster Mania, Alien Arcade or Free Play. Follow the instructions to play.

2. Aim For The Shape 123

Slide the **On/Off/Mode Switch** to 123 to enter this activity. Try to score a basket when you see the requested shape, number or object shown on the screen. Press the **Select Button** to choose from 3 levels of play. You will automatically level up when you complete a challenge.

3. Buzzer Beater Challenge

Slide the **On/Off/Mode Switch** to **li** to enter this activity. Press the **Select Button** to choose between 1 or 2 players. See how many baskets you can make in the time given! (60 seconds per player)

CARE & MAINTENANCE

- 1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
- 2. Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat source.
- 3. Remove the batteries when the unit is not in use for an extended period of time.
- 4. Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces and do not expose the unit to moisture or water.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If for some reason the unit stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

- 1. Please turn the unit **OFF**.
- 2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
- 3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
- 4. Turn the unit ON. The unit should now be ready to play with again.
- 5. If the product still does not work, install a brand new set of batteries.
