

# INSTRUCTIONS

#### WARNING:


Adult assembly required for battery installation. Keep batteries out of reach of children.

# **⚠** CAUTION:

Adult assembly required. This product contains small parts. For your child's safety, do not let your child play with the toy until it is completely assembled.

#### BATTERY REMOVAL AND INSTALLATION

- 1. Make sure the unit is turned Off.
- Find the battery cover located on the back of the **Electronic Panel**. Use a screwdriver to loosen the screw and then open the battery cover.
- If used batteries are present, remove these batteries from the unit by pulling up on one end of each battery.



- Install 2 new AA (AM-3/LR6) batteries following the diagram inside the battery box. (For best performance, alkaline batteries or fully charged Ni-MH rechargeable batteries are recommended).
- 5. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.

#### IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION

- Insert batteries with the correct polarity (+ and -).
- · Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable batteries.
- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.
- Do not short-circuit the supply terminals.
- · Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- · Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of batteries in fire.

#### RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES

- Remove rechargeable batteries (if removable) from toy before charging.
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.

# Disposal of batteries and product



The crossed-out wheelie bin symbols on products and batteries, or on their respective packaging, indicates they must not be disposed of in domestic waste as they contain substances that can be damaging to the environment and human health.

The chemical symbols Hg, Cd or Pb, where marked, indicate that the battery contains more than the specified value of mercury (Hg), cadmium (Cd) or lead (Pb) set out in the Batteries and Accumulators Regulation.

In the UK, give this toy a second life by disposing of it at a small electricals collection point\* so all of its materials can be recycled.



# **ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS**

With the **Sort & Discover Activity Wagon** safety comes first. To ensure your child's safety, adult assembly is required. For your child's safety, do not let your child play with the toy until it is fully assembled.

 Please make sure the VTech® logo side of the Bottom Panel is facing up. Connect the Electronic Panel and the Side Panel to the Bottom Panel first. Next, connect the two End Panels to the Bottom Panel. You will hear the pieces click together when inserted correctly. Use the 9 Screws to secure the panels together.


Electronic Panel

2 End Panels












Attach the 4 Wheels to the End Panels. Push the Wheels onto the supports until you hear the Wheels click twice and are flush with the supports.







#### Note:

Attaching the wheels requires firm pressure. We recommend placing the wagon on it's side on the floor, then pushing down on the wheels.

Connect the Handle to the End Panels. Push the Handle down until you hear the Handle click into place.



## PRODUCT FEATURES

1. On/Off/Volume Switch

To turn the unit **On**, slide the **On/Off/ Volume Switch** to the **Low Volume**(i)) or the **High Volume**(ii)) position.
You will hear a song and phrases.
To turn the unit **Off**, slide the **On/Off/ Volume Switch** to the **Off** ● position.



#### 2. Automatic Shut-Off

To preserve battery life, the **Sort & Discover Activity Wagon** will automatically shut down after approximately 30 seconds without input. The unit can be turned on again by interacting with any of the features on the **Electronic Panel**.

#### NOTE

If the unit powers down or if the light fades out during play, please install a new set of batteries.

# **ACTIVITIES**

#### 1. Number Buttons

Press the **Number Buttons** to hear numbers, colours, shapes and melodies. The light will flash with the sound.

#### 2. Roller

Spin the **Roller** to hear fun sounds and short tunes. When a short tune is playing, roll the **Roller** again quickly to speed up the short tune. The light will flash with the sound.

#### 3. Twisting Lion

Twist the **Twisting Lion** to hear cute phrases, sounds, songs and music. The light will flash with the sound.

#### 4. Flip Page

Turn the **Flip Page** to hear the animals identified, short tunes and playful sounds. The light will flash with the sound









#### Peek-a-boo Doors

Slide the **Peek-a-boo Doors** to learn about the animals, hear sounds and short tunes. The light will flash with the sound.



#### 6. Motion Sensor

Push or pull the wagon to activate the **Motion Sensor** and hear a phrase, fun sounds and short tunes.

#### 7. Shape Sorting

For added fun, push the **Shape Sorting Blocks** into the matching slots on either end of the wagon.

# **CARE & MAINTENANCE**

- 1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.

- Remove the batteries if the unit will not be in use for an extended period of time.
- Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces and do not expose the unit to moisture or water.

# **TROUBLESHOOTING**

If for some reason the unit stops working or malfunctions, please follow these steps:

- 1. Turn the unit Off.
- 2. Interrupt the power supply by removing the batteries.
- 3. Let the unit stand for a few minutes, then replace the batteries.
- 4. Turn the unit **On**. The unit should now be ready to use again.
- 5. If the unit still does not work, install a new set of batteries. If the problem persists, please contact our Consumer Services Department and a service representative will be happy to help you.
